 - *All classes are eligible for MHSA, MOHJO & COE points, but you must be a member of each association to receive the points
 - *Facilities will be open the day before the show for schooling at \$20 per horse
 - *Schooling will be available the morning before the hunter/jumper classes begin and again before the dressage
 - *Non showing horses will pay \$20 schooling fee
 - *TACK SWAP ALL DAY, no fee to consign your tack and apparel
 - *Concessions will be available courtesy of Dale
 - *Current Coggins must be presented at the show office prior to showing
 - ***COE Medallion class (19) There will be a special end of the year award for the highpoint rider in the class. The rider must compete in this class in 3 out of 4 COE shows to be eligible.
